



## EYELASH EXTENSIONS AFTERCARE GUIDE

- It takes up to 24 hrs for the eyelash extensions adhesive to fully cure from the inside out and any of the following will be damaging for the bond between natural lash and extension resulting in premature partial loss of your extensions.

### FOR THE NEXT 24HRS DO NOT:

- Expose your eyelash extensions to water or moisture
- Rub, tug, or “play” with them
- Apply any cosmetics (especially oil based/cream based) near your lash line

### AFTER 24HRS HAVE PASSED:

- Wash your eyelashes daily with an oil-free facial cleanser. It is best to invest in eyelash extension cleansers as they are made specifically for lash extensions and increases the longevity of the lashes. Clean your lashes thoroughly, a build up of dust, makeup and natural skin oil on the lash line affects the durability of eyelash adhesive and could also lead to potential skin problems and infections in or around your eyes.

### HOW TO CLEAN YOUR EYELASH EXTENSIONS:

- Splash your eyes with warm water.
- Using your ring finger or soft eyelash cleansing brush gently massage your cleansing product along the lash line and eyelashes, then splash with water until all soap is rinsed away.
- Pat dry the skin around your lashes with dry towel and let your lashes air dry.
- Once dry, use a disposable mascara wand to gently brush and separate your extensions.
- Do not worry if you see 2-3 lashes per eye fall out, we normally lose 1-5 natural lashes per day without noticing while we wash our face or sleep, it is normal.

### Do NOTS and TIPS:

- DO NOT wear waterproof mascara, this will cause extensions to come off
- DO NOT tug or pull your eyelashes as this will cause damage to your natural lashes.
- Avoid extreme heat such as saunas, stove, fire, grills, etc.
- You may have to adjust your sleeping position, sleeping on your side or stomach may damage your extensions if your eyelashes make contact with your pillow causing friction. Silk or satin pillows prevent friction and contoured eye masks are available if you sleep with one.
- When coming for your fill-in appointment, ensure your eyelashes are clean and free of makeup. It is impossible to give your lashes a thorough cleanse and any residue will prevent proper bonding between your natural lashes and extensions resulting them to come off.
- Schedule your fill-in appointment as recommended every 2-3 weeks to keep your lashes looking beautiful and full due to natural daily lash shedding. Anything after 3 weeks will be considered as a full set of lashes due to growth and the process of lash shedding.
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
